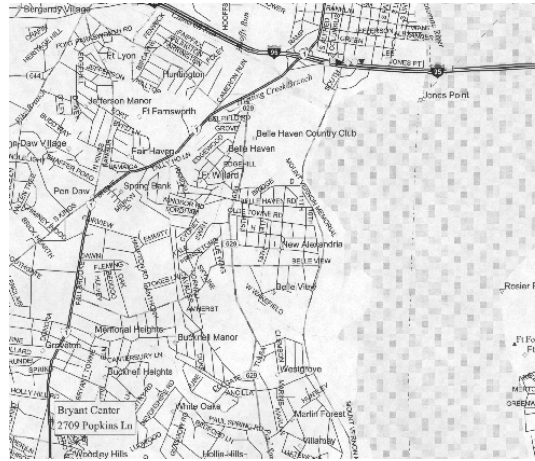

Our meeting place is at the Bryant Education Center, 2709 Popkins Lane, Alexandria, VA. See map below for details.

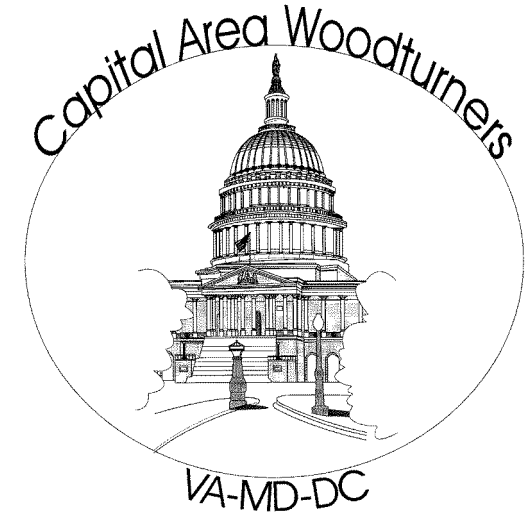
